- Working with our contract partners and others in our provider network to make sure they have the information and resources they need and to stay in regular contact regarding updated guidelines and precaution/disruptions regarding residential and hospital-based care
- Appointed David Ross, associate director, as the MHRB lead staff in addressing any issues impacting the public behavioral health system
