- expired and unused medications
- over-the-counter medications
- medication samples
- pet medications
- vitamins, inhalers
- medicated ointment/lotion/drops
- liquid medications in leak-proof containers



### DON'T DROP THESE

- needles/lancets/syringes
- thermometers
- IV bags
- bloody or infectious waste
- hydrogen peroxide
- empty pill bottles/containers, aerosol cans
- personal products (non-medicated shampoo, etc.)
